## National Junior Honor Society Scholarship for Academic Achievement Tri-Valley Endowment Fund Scholarship Application for the 2018-2019 School Year Tri-Valley Endowment Fund – PO Box 758, Dresden, Ohio 43821

The National Junior Honor Society was established at the Tri-Valley Middle School to recognize outstanding achievement in their middle school students. An invitation for membership is extended to 7 and 8 grade students based on five criteria. They are: Scholarship, Leadership, Character, Citizenship, and Service.

As a tribute to their success and to the success of students who have maintained the organization's characteristics, the NJHS members established a \$1,000 post-secondary scholarship for Tri-Valley Graduates through the Tri-Valley Endowment Fund in 2009. Donations are made to the fund annually, primarily through the Student-Staff Basketball Game held in April.

## **Application Criteria**

**Scholarship:** Must have a minimum GPA of 3.75 as required by the National Honor Society. Applicant must be a member in good standing of the National Honor Society.

**Leadership:** Must demonstrate leadership skills through extracurricular activities, community service organizations and/or other clubs and activities.

**Character:** Must demonstrate integrity and independent initiative in all activities.

**Citizenship:** Must demonstrate respect for person, property and country.

**Service:** Must show compassion for others through community service. Applicant must complete the service hour requirements of the National Honor Society.

Applicants must be Tri-Valley High School graduates and will be rated on cumulative grade point average, need (sources for funding post-secondary education), essay response and teacher recommendations (2).

<u>Completed</u> applications must be received in the TVHS Guidance Office by 3:00 p.m. Friday, April 12, 2019. Scholarship recipients will receive their award notice at the Tri-Valley High School Senior Awards Assembly. If the student is attending post-secondary classes and is unable to attend the ceremony, a representative may be present to accept the award. A \$1,000 check will be written to recipients from the Treasurer's Office upon receipt of their letter of acceptance and a copy of their tuition invoice. All awards are to be used for the 2019 - 2020 school year. Students must re-apply each year. Discrepancies or falsification discovered during the application process will result in the student's elimination. If discrepancies or falsifications are discovered following the award, the student must return the award to the Tri-Valley Endowment Fund.

## **Instructions for completion of scholarship application:**

- 1. Student must complete the attached application form.
- 2. Student must attach the most current grading period's transcript from Tri-Valley High School or their current post-secondary institution.
- 3. Student must attach a letter of recommendation from two (2) certified classroom instructors with whom they have had classroom experience.
- 4. Students must complete an essay of no more than 2 one-sided pages that answers the following questions:

How would this scholarship benefit you?

What other scholarships have you received to date or are you guaranteed to receive by fall term?

How will your post-secondary education be funded (discounting this scholarship)?

Describe your academic accomplishments throughout your elementary, middle and secondary education.

Describe your extra-curricular and community service activities and accomplishments.

What are your employment experiences?

What are your educational and professional objectives?

Add any other information you think would be helpful to the committee in making this selection.
