

# Minecraft Sells 54 Million Copies Console Editions, PC Editions Of Minecraft Pass PC

Mojang's Patrick Geuder said that Minecraft's blocky sandbox is in the process of reaching 54 million copies across all platforms. Geuder also announced on Twitter that sales of the console (Xbox 360, PS3) versions have already surpassed that of the PC and Mac versions. The game will be available on Xbox One, PS4 or Vita in August. The Vita version of the game is Cross-Buy compatible and is free for users who have the PS3 version. Xbox 360 and PS4 owners who own the game on their Xbox 360 or PS3 will now be able download the latest versions for \$5.

Players' first moments with Minecraft were in May 2009, when the alpha version was made available, two years prior to its official release in November. Mojang and its creator Markus "Notch" Persson have celebrated many sales milestones since then, most recently noting that 15 million copies of the PC version were sold by April. Minecraft games The Xbox 360 version sold 12 million copies, while the Pocket Edition for iOS or Android has reached 21 million. [Image: Mojang]
