Additionally, the site clearly suggests not using or including references from your high school achievements and not writing about controversial subjects or topics just to sound different or unique.

To be in the right direction, you may also want to address the issue being asked, if there is, before drafting the essay.

Most importantly, make the paper distinctive by including a specific example, such as an anecdote or an event unique to you, meaning it won't be written by another applicant.

It also states that applicants must address important topics, including your academic career with description of your performance, along with educational choices and path.

But aside from such a history, the school also wants applicants to include personal elements, such as describing ways in which culture has influenced him or her as an individual.

The website also highlights a specific format to follow, including length of between 750 and 1000 words. Go to the official site for the complete description of what they need your personal essay to contain and how to format it.
