 - o that the Senate had reached cloture on the FAA Reauthorization Bill;
 - o that the FAA Reauthorization Bill wouldn't be voted on until Monday/Tuesday;
 - o that few (if any) amendments would be added; and, most importantly,
 - o that Sen. Blumenthal's amendment banning carry-on e-cigs was all but dead.
- Today, we are pleased to announce that the FAA Reauthorization bill passed without Sen. Blumenthal's amendment which was never heard and is now officially dead.
