

The Pearl River Declaration

Of Full Autonomy and Peaceful Transition



PREAMBLE

We are the Pearl River Group (PRG), originally named the Staunton-Gough Group (SGG), so named after 13 Staunton Street, Central, and 24 Gough Street, Sheung Wan – the historic headquarters of the Revive China Society and meeting place of the Four Bandits, who 100 years ago overthrow the last Emperor of China and transformed China into a Republic.



We hereby declare our existence and purpose to the Chinese Communist Party and to the people of China and the World. We are a small group based in South China, with links in Taiwan, Tibet, Xinjiang, Shanghai, as well as across China and internationally.

The roots and history of our Republican society will not be discussed in this document, but we have never forgotten the Republic of China, the Beijing Spring and Democracy Wall Movement, Tiananmen, the Jasmine Revolution of 2011, or any of the struggle for Democracy in China, which is still ongoing. The blood of Tiananmen and the suffering of the heroes of the Chinese Democracy Movement lives on in us, as it does in everyone struggling for Democracy and justice in China, whether in the region or with our allies and friends abroad.

The colors of the PRG are Blue and White, colors which must be reclaimed in the name of Liberty and Justice. They were the colors of the Revive China Society, founded in 1894, the revolutionary group of Sun Yat-sen which overthrew the Qing dynasty and established the Republic of China (ROC), and continue to be used on the flag of Taiwan.

The Blue Sky with a White Sun was designed by Lu Haodong, martyr of the Republican Revolution and co-founder of the Revive China Society with Dr Sun. He was born in Shanghai but his ancestral home and place of passing was Guangdong. He presented the Blue Sky with a White Sun in Hong Kong on February 21st, 1895, to the Society for Regenerating China, founded one year earlier.

When their plans for uprising in Guangzhou were discovered, rather than flee to safety, Lu returned to their base of operations to burn a roster containing important documents and the names of his fellow revolutionaries, and was captured.

Taken for interrogation he refused to kneel before the magistrate who said, "You are a talented young man. Why did you get yourself in trouble that would cost you your life? I feel sorry for you that you don't value your life," to which the brave Lu replied:

"China is a vast country and it has the highest population in the world. Poverty is at an extreme because the Qing government is authoritarian and incompetent in foreign policy. My comrades and I planned an uprising with the aim of overthrowing the Qing government and replacing it with a new Republican government. I intended to kill one or two persons like you who serve the Qing government. Now that our plan has failed, I can't kill you but you can kill me. What's there to feel sorry about?"

Lu was executed on November the 7th, 1895, and Sun Yat-sen called him "the first person in Chinese history who sacrificed his life for a democratic revolution."

Black and Yellow are the colors of the Resistance, of the local struggle in Hong Kong and later the region, colors which we ourselves wear on the frontlines and will continue to use. But Blue is the color of the Goal, of Liberty, of Democracy.

Our Group is calling for a much larger struggle that must draw on history, international politics, and look also to the future, and use an appropriate symbology, for symbols are powerful forces both of unification and of opposition. The PRG uses Blue and White, and we call for nothing less than the creation of a Free China, a Democratic China, a Blue China.

We assert that the Hong Kong Police and Communist organizations can only be given one color: Red, the long-established color of Communism and Socialism, the color of the true evil they are serving, the true masters behind the local government, and the color of the blood they beat out of the citizens for their rule by Terror. Blue for the police only confuses the true struggle that is going on, which is against Communism, Dictatorship, Totalitarianism.

One day, when the transition to Liberty is complete, the establishment of Democracy secure and without threat, we may reclaim the color Red and employ the Tricolor of many Free Nations if that is the Will of the People. But for now Red is the color of the opposition, of Communism, murder, kidnap, torture, and persecution.

We call also for the end of 'anti-Mainlander' sentiments among those sectors of the local Hong Kong population that have them. Just as the PRG is calling for far broader goals, so also we are calling for a far broader mindset. We must remember that no matter how much we have suffered in Hong Kong thus far, it is nothing compared to what the Democratic Mainlanders have suffered.

One death (or eight), one eye, 5 kidnappings, is nothing compared to the deaths, torture, and kidnapping suffered in Mainland China under this cruel regime. We have not given as much blood as Tiananmen, so we must look for friends and allies in the people of China, and not believe the deranged sentiments of the few dedicated Communists among them to be representative of the true hopes and aspirations of an entire population of 1.4 billion, all of whom suffer a far greater repression then our free city has ever known.

We must call to mind Dr. Sun Yat-sen, who wished for the dignity of every citizen of China, not only the Liberty of one small city therein. We must envisage, and struggle for, a new China, a democratic China, where every citizen enjoys the rights, liberties, dignity, civil responsibility and political participation that we strive for, which we want for every people on earth.

We must struggle until all people of China are free of the Communist tyranny and propaganda they suffer. *Nothing less will safeguard us*. *There is no liberty and dignity possible for us without a complete transformation of China*. 7 million cannot withstand 1.4 billion. A complete transformation of China is the only possibility for safety in the region and perhaps in the world.

And how can the 1.4 Billion people of China be denied their true rights and dignities by a tiny Communist party? 91.6% of China is Han. How can an entire race, and entire ethnicity, be forced to endure such tyrannical rule while the rest of the world enjoys freedom?

No dignity, only humiliation. Think of all the other nations that enjoy liberty, and how small many of them are in comparison with this great country. Image also what a force for good a Democratic China would be in the world. What a massive addition to the Free World to stand up for Liberty everywhere with their Democratic allies throughout the world.

The Communists and Local Government talk about ending the protests to save the economy. But if tyranny is allowed to reign then the economy will be a crony economy. Do the poor have rights in China? They are crushed, and we will be also. Even the rich can be seized under false charges and fleeced of all his earnings in Communist China.

Political safety is a necessary prerequisite for economic safety. The protests are not the problem: *Not* protesting is the problem. *Not* protesting is what allows tyranny to reign unrestrained, as it wishes to, as it demands. Tyranny resorts to violence, so unless you are willing to suffer violence, and battle the violence of assertive tyranny until the entire tyranny is overthrown, then you will never enjoy freedom.

Communism doesn't deserve power over a single person, let alone a nation, let alone the vast Zhongguo with a population of 1.4 billion. A sick philosophy that always resorts to crushing the individual for the false claim of serving society. Murdering, torturing, threatening the population 'for the population'. Destroying the people 'for the people'. Crushing the people 'for the people'. Denying the common person any say or participation in government 'for the common person'.

Truth and Trust must be fundamental to every society, every relationship between the ruler and the ruled, and the only way to safeguard society is to extend independent political power as broadly throughout that society as is possible, and to do that in China we must smash the one party dictatorship and overthrow Communism.

GOVERNANCE IN CHINA

Every relationship is a negotiation, with give and take on both sides, including the relationship between a government and its people. The Communist Party of China does not believe in the Consent of the Governed, but rules by the Terror of the Governed, and therefore has no Legitimacy. International standards of Government Legitimacy must be established and enforced. The Communist party's concepts of the individual, of the state, and of the relationship between them are cruel and unusual, backward and destructive, murderous and pernicious, unholy and sinister.

The Communist Party demands that the relationship between government and people must be a tyrannical one. There is to be no free thought about politics by the ruled. No Free Speech in the population. No matter what the Communist Party does the people must agree and voice their agreement, and any disagreement will earn them physical punishment or death. This is an unacceptable, infantile, abusive relationship. We are not abused children to be terrified of our government. We are not cattle to be slaughtered and abused by our government.

If a husband beats his wife or a father beats his children then the state steps in. Spouse abuse and child abuse is an unacceptable relationship, and so is population abuse. The violations of the Communists are blatant, widespread, growing and flagrant, and China complains about foreign interference like a child beater complains about state interference. When a child cannot free itself of an abusive parent rescue is needed from outside forces, forces which we now beg to save us.

Every relationship is a negotiation, and we refuse the leadership of the Chinese Communist Party. We refuse their governance. And all of China must refuse their governance. A man cannot have a wife by terror, only by consent. A marriage without consent is void, and is no marriage at all, but a violent captivity.

Likewise a government is invalid which rules by terror and not by consent. This must be established as an internationally enforced standard of law: that no government may exist without the consent of the governed, and that no government may forbid the free speech of its people; no government may prevent its people from voicing their consent or dissent. And, lacking the consent of the governed, an international body will oversee a free election for the establishment of a new government which has that Consent of the Governed.

What makes you our ruler? Armed force? Beatings? Imprisonment? Torture? Murder? Your rule is invalid. You are not our rulers. You are rejected by the people. No validity, only violence. No free speech, only Tiananmen. We reject Rule by Terror, and demand Rule by Consent!

The oath of the Revive China Society of Sun Yat-sen, which launched their complete transformation of China from Hong Kong, included the words "*Revive Zhonghua*", and we call for nothing less than the dignity and liberty of the entire Zhongguo.

"Zhongguo", the Middle Kingdom, is a name that stems back 3000 years, its earliest known use being the famous ritual bronze vessel 'He Zun' of the Western Zhou dynasty, and is a name that should be beloved to the people of Hong Kong and China – a free China, and which should reverberate throughout the world with historic marvel and as a force of good and democracy and freedom in the world.

The Chinese Communist Party must be replaced and the Republic of China reestablished, and we call upon the CCP itself to partake in this transition peacefully, at its own initiative, and not force its people into a struggle against state power for these rights and dignities that it has no right to seize from the population.

Of Cantonese and Hakka descent, Dr Sun Yat-sen move to Hong Kong at the age of 17 and studied at the Mong Kok Diocesan Boys' School and Queen's College in Causeway Bay, and earned his license as a medical doctor at the Hong Kong College of Medicine for Chinese, Pok Fu Lam, which later became the University of Hong Kong. On February 20th, 1923, at the University of Hong Kong, Dr. Sun Yat-sen delivered a talk entitled "Why I Became a Revolutionist", here paraphrased.

"During this visit to Hong Kong I feel as though I have returned home, because Hong Kong and this University were my intellectual birthplace. Where and how did I get my revolutionary and modern ideas? I got my ideas in this very place; in the Colony of Hong Kong. Hong Kong impressed me a great deal, because there was orderly calm and because there was artistic work being done without interruption."

"I went to my home in Zhongshan twice a year and immediately noticed the great difference. There was disorder instead of order, insecurity instead of security. Each time it was like this, year after year. I compared Zhongshan with Hong Kong and, although they were 50 miles apart, the difference of the Governments impressed me very much."

He found in Hong Kong that *purity was the rule and corruption was the exception*, unlike China where the very opposite was true. And the higher up the government in China the more corrupt it was, with Peking being most corrupt of all.

He discovered that the good governments of the West were not simply natural to those places at first, and that the West had suffered just the same corruption and cruelty, but that at some point the Western peoples had decided and declared that they would no longer endure such tyranny, and had risen up to change this corruption and cruelty into Liberty and justice, and he released that China could also rise up and do the same.

"It was necessary to give up my profession of healing men and take up my part to cure the country. That is the answer to the question: where did I get my revolutionary ideas? It is entirely in Hong Kong." Hong Kong has changed all of China before and will do so again. We will serve as the light of China to lead their way out of darkness, but China must rise up and follow. Let us all move together towards Freedom, once again, and overthrow those who would call us their leaders but threaten us into lives of fear, lives both cruel and unusual, humiliating and depressing.

Massive surveillance, always and everywhere, murder, kidnap, and torture, fear and trembling, from birth to death, for us and our children; *is this the dignity of the Chinese people?* The Communists expend massive amounts of capital and state resources into repression; capital and resources that could and should be used not to crush the people but to enrich the people.

The state should be transparent to the people, not the people transparent to the state, which has total powers of intrusion. 2 million Uighurs of Xinjiang have been put into "reeducation camps" since 2017, undergoing harsh living conditions, torture, and constant political indoctrination to strip them of any attachment of their Islamic faith. Even *genetic surveillance* is now being used. And Xinjiang is just the testing ground for a new China, a red China, totalitarian in a way the world has never ever seen before or known.

"Facial recognition, artificial intelligence, and speech monitoring enable and supercharge the Chinese Communist Party's drive to "standardize" its Uighur population. Uighurs can be sent to re-education camps for a vast array of trivial offenses, many of which are benign expressions of faith. The party monitors compliance through unrelenting electronic surveillance of online and psychical activities. This modern-day panopticon requires enormous amounts of labor, but is serving as a testing ground for new technologies of surveillance that might render this process cheaper and more efficient for the state."

The Communist government has no right to interfere in the lives of the citizens in the many ways that it does, *and that is no true purpose of government at all*. The Communists are a criminal entity ruling a frightened people with violence. They are a Mafia.

National Security is the excuse the Communists use to destroy the People's Security. The cockroach is Xi. The cockroaches are the Chinese Communist Party, a group that has killed so many tens of millions of people and causes the suffering of over a billion. Their death toll is larger than the Nazi Party, and the Free World cannot treat them as any less of a criminal entity and murderous regime.

'No one can question the leader or political structure' is an unacceptable requirement, and most dangerous form of society, guaranteeing corruption. Compare that with 'Everyone must question the leader and political structure,' as in the West, which is its greatest strength: a true and honest understanding of the corruptibility of man and political powers, and checks and balances and transparency built systemically into the political machinery to prevent that corruption of nature from manifesting as corruption in politics, and to discover, expose, and to make it possible to punish it if it does.

Western Political Models are not built upon mandatory trust in the leader and ruling party, enforced by terror and violence, as in Communist China. They are founded upon the very opposite: a fundamental *distrust* of leaders and political parties, and the individual freedom necessary *for every citizen* as a counterweight against political corruption.

Transparency and accountability. Check and balances. Equal and independent branches of government, and massive civil participation, universal sufferance and democratically elected representatives serving limited terms, and the power of the free press and the free and sovereign individual.

In the West: as great an extension of political power downward into the population as is organizationally manageable. In Communist China: as great a centralization of power upward into a one-party dictatorship as is violently possible, with a claim that this will produce a just and free society, which is madness, and has never been the truth and never will be the truth, but will only ever produce as great a tyranny as is violently possible.

In the West: an absolute belief in the Free Speech of the individual, which – given to all of society – is the greatest possible security any society could ever have against the emergence of tyranny. A Free and Independent Press. But in Communist China: as great a crushing of the Free Speech of the individual as is violently possible, with the claim that this will protect society, but only ever ensures the rise of as great a tyranny as is violently possible. A State Propaganda Press.

Consent of the Governed, not Coercion.

Government of the people, by the people, for the people.

The Mandate not of Heaven, but of Earth.

If any society sets up instruments of power and repression like the Communists have, blind faith in the state will not stop those powers from becoming corrupt. And the corruption will inevitably spread to every sector of society, high and low, and the forces of good in society will be everywhere crushed, with the result that society is everywhere bad, and everyone suffers.

We appeal to all strata of Chinese society, including members of the Communist party and armed forces: use reason. Think in the long term. When a system becomes corrupt no body is safe, neither the high nor the low. Men destroy each other – and each other's' families, for great or petty gain, or for mere personal squabbles and malevolence and enjoyment.

The low officials will crush the low peoples, and the high officials will crush the high peoples, and the officials low and high will crush each other. Corrupt position and corrupt benefit, in a winner-take-all struggle, as has always plagued Communist parties.

Those who rise up to the top even in business, like Jack Ma, will be destroyed by corruption at the top. But those who are far below will be destroyed by the corruption at the bottom. Every peaceful and innocent neighbor will be destroyed for some petty malevolence. Destroyed for mere pleasure with mere accusation, their family and seed gone from the earth for the joy of the vindictive, so that every person in society must fear every other.

The vicious state is hungry for victims, for supposed political enemies, high and low, to justify its existence. No one in society is safe. Everyone is afraid. Afraid in a way no society should ever be: afraid to speak the truth, afraid to even see or know the truth lest it be spoken by accident and punished. Afraid of death and torture. Living a lie, living a falsehood, which will destroy them mercilessly none the less. But no society can turn its back on truth without suffering horrible, murderous consequences.

"It's essential tyranny exists, to arrest this political criminal. It's essential tyranny exists, to kidnap and torture him. It's essential tyranny exists, to harass his family and children, and erase his seed from this earth, and swallow them whole into darkness, gone from the world of the living forever and suffering in the dungeons of the undying victims."

The fool, as Xi Jing Ping can only be called, abolished term limits 106 years after the Xinhai Revolution of 1911-1912 forced the abdication of the last Emperor of China. Xi has thereby grossly retarded China's Communist party into an even more monstrous enormity, for his own personal greed and vainglory. But glory is not his, only infamy, and history will forever desecrate his memory. Over a billion people suffering for the base, cruel, selfish and malevolent desires of a sick few.

Xi's so-called 'campaign against corruption' of 2012 can forever repeat itself, again and again and again, targeting the "Tiger and Flies", the high-level officials and the local civil servants. Communist collaborators: none of your gains are ever safe. They never will be. Short of Liberty, you will live forever in terror. You and your family. Your children and children's children will tremble in greater and greater fear. A government that rules its people by terror rules every complicit collaborator in its ranks with exactly the same terror.

Collaborators, your freedom and liberty is as non-existent as the freedom and liberty of your population. Your dignity is as non-existent as the dignity of the trembling people. Over 100,000 fell into the jaws of Xi; military and civil leaders. The unspoken rule of 'Politburo Standing Committee (PSC) Criminal Immunity' did not protect former government leaders.

A REVERSE MAGNA CARTA, WHERE THE KING HAS REESTABLISHED HIS RIGHT TO FLEECE AND PERSECUTE THE NOBLES AS WELL AS THE COMMONERS, AND THE RULE OF LAW IS TAKEN AWAY FROM ALL.

Can a ruling party withhold rights from the commoners but hope to retain them for themselves? Such has never been the case, and never will be the case. It is impossible. *Tyranny for anyone will become tyranny for everyone*. The nobles withhold the rights of its people, and the people's responsibilities of civic engagement and protection from political repression, *only by inviting the same tyranny to be applied to themselves*. If you establish tyranny it will be extended to you also, whoever you are.

Finally the party that has so long tyrannized its people has those same powers of tyranny applied to their own ranks, as Mao did more bombastically during the Cultural Revolution of

1966-1976, a horror which claimed 500,000 - 2 million lives, only 5 years after his Great Leap Forward killed 30 million others.

State power of murder, kidnap, torture, and dungeons of eternal darkness cannot be built without every single person being in danger of falling into them, officials included. It was the folly of former leaders to think themselves safe from the tyranny them built and subject the population to, just as the current leadership is entirely unsafe from being swallowed up at any moment.

First they crushed the peasants and I did not speak out – because I'm not a peasant.

Then they crushed the proletariat and I did not speak out – because I'm not proletariat.

Then they crushed the bourgeoisie and I did not speak out – because I'm not bourgeoisie.

But now they're crushing me – and there's no one speaking out.

Slander, kidnap, torture – and there's no one left to speak out.

Murder, rape, my family – and they're all clapping with applause.

Silence today is terror tomorrow, and silence yesterday is now terror today. Why do you keep silent? To keep the cruel and unusual life they restrict you to today, which they will painfully take away from you tomorrow.

Nor is Communist complicity among the commoners excusable. Mao created the Red Guard of his Cultural Revolution to seize power and eliminate his political rivals, his former friends and partners, now branded "Cow Monsters and Snake Demons". Then, having achieved his political ends against the ruling party, he eliminated the very Red Guard by which he did this by launching the "Up to the Mountain and Down to the Countryside Movement", exiling his young Communist collaborators among the common people. Literally 10% of the 1970 urban population was relocated to rural areas, with over a million youth sent every year.

"We too have two hands, let us not laze about in the city. The intellectual youth must go to the country, and will be educated from living in rural poverty." And there is no power in China to stop the Communist Party from doing this again, or any other ridiculous barbarity against its population that it so wills.


The people must rise up against this state of affairs. We call upon the people, the civil leaders, and the military, all: support a transition to Liberty. You will never be safe until Liberty is enjoyed by all.

Do not resist the will of the people with massive repression. The change is necessary, inevitable, and just. Reject the philosophy of one-party dictatorship – not just one-man

dictatorship, and reject the violent repression and cruel terror necessary to maintain it. And when people suffer and die - and they will, never give up, for it is only when we persevere that we will overthrow this tyranny.

If you ever give up, if the pain and loss ever causes you to flinch, then you are teaching the Communist Party only one thing: violence works. We must teach them the opposite: violence will not stop us, and violence not save them.

We must all reject the philosophy of the crushed individual, constantly monitored and afraid, forever motivated by fear and groaning. Embrace the philosophy of civic participation, of decentralizing power outward in a democratic fashion to all peoples of every sector of society. Embrace Liberty, who calls to us and to every nation, who tells us to be free and that our lives – without freedom – have no dignity or security.



"My fellow students, you and I have studied in this English colony and in an English university, and we must learn by English examples. We must carry this English example of good government to every part of China."

It was only by adopting Western Economic Models that China was saved from the genocidal disaster and ferocious humiliation that was Communist Economics. Likewise it is only by adopting Western Political Models that China will be saved from the genocidal disaster and ferocious humiliation that is Communist Politics.

We must write our own, new, free Constitution, modeled on the Constitutions of the Free World. Society must be ruled and laws be made by democratically elected representatives of the people, and never by a one-party dictatorship. An Open and Free society, which not only allows but expects the participation of the citizenry in its political philosophy and processes. The Light and Glory of Liberty.

China must become such a beacon of Liberty that even if the whole Free World were to collapse into the darkness of tyranny, then China still would stand up as a Democratic beacon for the world to look to for Freedom, to carry on this tradition of humane and just society. In this struggle the individual can die, but Liberty must live on and survive for the Nation, for the World, and triumph. Revive Zhonghua! Liberty for Zhongguo!

COMMUNIST CHINA AND THE FREE WORLD

Trust not tyranny. Trust not tyranny to restrain itself, which it never has, and never will. Tyranny anywhere threatens freedom everywhere.

When Neville Chamberlain announced "Peace in Our Time" he had just opened the doors for the deaths of 70-85 million people, and the horrors and grief immeasurable of brutal war which would torture many, many millions more.

He opened the doors of Auschwitz and Dachau to the Jewish men, women, and children. *Treblinka, Belzec, Majdanek, Mauthausen, Belsen, Buchenwald.* That is because tyranny, when given a chance, will always spread. It is the nature of evil to covet more. To claim more victims.

The rise of Hitler was not the problem, only, of the Jewish nation, nor only the woe of Poland. Not the problem of Europe alone, but a problem which engulfed the whole world in the dark fires of bloody war. Likewise, now, the rise of a Communist China is a threat not only to one city, or one region, but to China's every neighbor and to the world.

If the Free World allows this new, cruel society to emerge and thinks that it will not be affected and endangered then they have not learned the lessons of history. A new axis of evil arises, of nations like China and Iran and North Korea, whose philosophy of the crushed individual and the mighty state is cruel and unholy, and is antithetical to the Western philosophy, and will seek to overthrow this Free philosophy and reduce people everywhere into a dungeon of unfree barbarity.

Let the Free World never forget: World War II was almost lost. Tyranny almost won; tyranny most horrible. Liberty was almost destroyed; Liberty most sweet.

Let the Allied Nations of yesterday remember how hard won Liberty was, how painfully tyranny defeated, and know they can never again allow tyranny to rise up to threaten Liberty. Not today or any other day, if Liberty is to survive upon this earth, let alone flourish.

Tyranny anywhere threatens Liberty everywhere. Tyranny for anyone will become tyranny for everyone.

The FREE WORLD was almost destroyed, and stands in danger of rising tyranny again, tyranny now nuclear, technocratic, organized, invasive, malicious.

We are not merely calling for Western and Free World assistance in our struggle. We are warning the Free World of struggles yet to come, dangers already present. Allow China to remain in the grips of Communism, allow Hong Kong to fall into their reign of terror, and

tomorrow we will be at your doorstep, killing your women and children, "just following Communist orders."

Already the enemy is among you, with cloaks and daggers, spies and bribes, lies and assassinations, in business and in politics. Already they are in your ranks, and their voice comes through the mouth of some of your politicians.

Nazi Germany only had a population of 69 million in 1939, only 3% of the world population at the time. Communist China has a population of 1.4 billion people, which is 18.6% of the world population, almost 1 in 5 out of every person on earth, who will be a total surveillance state communist, forcibly part of a violent, criminal mafia trying to overthrow and capture your nation. Your very neighbors in the Free World unable not to be part of that dictatorship which you have allowed to exist.

No one safe, anywhere. That is the world they want to create. As in Communist China: so everywhere. That is the world they are striving for, to make Hong Kong and every Free Nation part of. That is the world you are allowing them to make. And that ever is the nature of tyranny throughout all of human history.

In 1989 the Berlin Wall Fell, but Communism was far from dead. Instead, in 1989, Communism massacred innocent students and citizens calling for Freedom in Tiananmen, and the Free World has allowed this vile state to grow and now threaten the entire world. The nations of Asia and the world will not be safe from this ever more powerful beast, ever more aggressive and belligerent.

Freedom is only protected by rising up against Terror and bringing about its overthrow. The Free World declared an end to Rule by Terror over 200 years ago, but tyranny forever seeks to rise up, and to battle Freedom to its painful death, and no population ever should be left to suffer tyranny anywhere in the world, who then will become resources for the war of tyranny against Freedom, of darkness against light, of death against life itself. If you think tyranny will restraint itself and you need not be concerned then you are wrong.

When the Americans revolted against the Crown of England they did so for reasons far less than our own. We struggle for the same goals as theirs, to have the same political system as theirs, but we struggle against horrors not the same as their but far, far greater.

Absolute political corruption, state harassment, murder, kidnapping, torture. Communism. Cruel and unusual lives shaped by the horrors of all-invasive surveillance wielded by a violent and corrupt state blatantly tyrannical. A concept of the crushed individual and the all-mighty state that is so dark and horrible that the founding fathers of America never had to suffer or struggle against or even consider.

The horrors we struggle against are greater, and our victory will have meaning for the entire world. A tyrannical China threatens not only the entire East, but will threaten the whole world, not least through its friendship and alliances with nefarious states such as North Korea

and Iran. A new Axis of Evil will emerge that will gladly bring the world to war again, this time nuclear.

Independent America's revolutionary transformation and rise brought Light to the whole world, but Communist China's rise threatens to bring darkness to the whole world. The Xinjiang Model combined with the Social Credit System is producing a new form of terror that the world has never seen before, which will spread itself out in the world, for corruption exists not only in China but in the hearts of men in all parts of the world, and powerful forces will emerge within the Free World which will seek to overthrow Freedom there for this new form of terror to reign also in the West.

This gross tyranny must be stopped at all costs, and overthrown, and replaced with a free and open and safe society. China is a vast nation, and anything less than the complete transformation of China into a Free and Democratic society is a threat to the whole world.

MANDATE OF THE PEOPLE

If in 2047 full Communism with its one-party dictatorship arrives in Hong Kong then all our struggles and gains today on the streets will have been for nothing. All of our freedoms will burn away, and our complaints of police brutality and the governments' improper conduct are just a very, very small taste of the horrors that will come upon us if the Communist Party still rules.

This struggle must be seen by the people of Hong Kong and the people of the Free World in the much larger context of Liberty against tyranny. Hong Kong is part of China, but China is part of the World, and is rising not only over Hong Kong, but seeks to rise over the whole world. Hong Kong must not become part of Communist China. China must become part of Free Hong Kong, and Free Hong Kong must become a fully Democratic part of the Free World.

China itself has suffered Communism for 70 years and must suffer this cruel and unusual terror for not one day more. The idea that such massive and unaccountable powers can be established and trusted to never be abused by an ever-pious ruling party is ridiculous. A sick and cruel fantasy of power for which over billion people are suffering. A lie, a falsehood, which could not exist without violence.

Every people on earth must be given, by international law, the right to Free Speech, and to voice their consent or dissent for their ruling party and political system, and to choose their leaders by Democratic elections with Universal Suffrage.

As when an individual breaks national law the national state can take action against him, so also when a nation breaks this international law then the Free World must take action against that nation. The Liberty of the Individual can be taken away by the national state for certain crimes, so also the rule of a party must become void and overturned when they violate the Mandate of the People to be ruled by it.

We call upon the Free World to establish a framework for the complete transformation of China into a Free and Open society, ruled by democratically elected representatives through universal suffrage, and to oversee and enforce this transition with military force. This is not a threat to the Sovereignty of a Nation, the Sovereignty of China, but the overthrow of a party that claims Sovereignty *over* a nation, over China and its people *without their Mandate*, and denies them the right to recall that Mandate which was never even given.

Transitional China: The Pearl River Framework.


1. The steeping down from all political positions - civil or military, and/or arrest of Xi Jing Ping, Wang Qishan, and Li Keqiang; with a CCP government ban on their ever reentering politics, with a minimum sentence of house arrest for life if the resist, but a worse sentence if they resist and repress the people or the party.


- 2. The reestablishment of Presidential term limits and the extension of terms limits to the General Secretary of the Communist Party and the Chairman of the Central Military Commission.
- 3. A new CCP law stating that any future attempts to abolish term limits for these three posts will earn the culprit lifelong house arrest as a minimum punishment.
- 4. The complete halt and removal of the Social Credit System and mass surveillance, and laws against any such pervasive form of technocratic intrusion ever being reestablished.
- 5. The end of cruel and unusual rule and punishment, including the use of surveillance, harassment, false charges, kidnapping, torture, and political reeducation.
- 6. The immediate establishment of Universal Suffrage in Hong Kong *and Macau* with the right of every citizen to run for the office of Chief Executive, without any power of veto by Beijing.
- 7. The immediate extension of this new "One Country, Two Systems" with Universal Suffrage and the right to run for office to:
 - The entire of the Liangguang region ("The Free South" Guangxi, Guangdong and Hainan)
 - Tibet and Xinjiang ("The Free West")
 - To a new 'Greater Shanghai' ("The Free East", comprising of Shanghai, Jiangsu, Anhui, and Zhejiang).

To be called 'Fully Autonomous Regions', they will have not only political representation but also fully independent powers, free of all Beijing influence and veto, and complete Freedom of Speech for the Individual, including criticism of the Communist Party of China. Together with the Independent state of Taiwan they will form a model for Chinas' transition to Democracy.

- 8. The legalization of the Democratic Party of China (DPC) in all of the *Fully Autonomous Regions*.
- 9. The allowance of the entry of Anglo-American, G7, and United Nations forces into these areas, as observers and enforcers of the peaceful transition to Democracy.
- 10. The extension of this system of Fully Autonomous Regions to Inner Mongolia and Ningxia ('The Free North", to later include Heilongjiang, Jilin and Liaoning), and to 'the Greater South' ("Nanfang", comprising of Liangguang, Fujian, Jiangxi, Hunan, Guizhou, Yunnan; and later Hubei, Chongqing and Sichuan).
- 11. The extension of this system of Fully Autonomous Regions to all remaining provinces of China except Beijing and Tianjin.
- 12. Finally, the extension of this system to Beijing and Tianjin, with the formal abolishment of the rule of the Chinese Communist Party and the formal reestablishment of the Republic of China, with its capital moved back to Nanjing, "The Southern Capital".

Chinese territorial integrity must be maintained as is, because the transformation that is required is so colossal that extra factors which could cause drastic and unpredictable dangers must be put off for future consideration, when the people themselves will be free to discuss and decide their fates without fear of violent repression. No future cause can divide our collective movement for Democracy throughout China.





Great amnesty must be exercised if a smooth transition is to be possible – if any transition is to be possible, and great resistance avoided, with needless violence and bloodshed. Not every past crime and past corruption can be avenged, nor should it, for men did crimes in Communism that they would not do in Democracy.

Those in power can be the greatest instigators of this change to Democracy, and should be sought as friends and allies, and taken as enemies only when they violently resist the will of the people and international community towards Liberty. But they need a Free World alliance they can trust to protect them against the violence of the Communist state they rebel against, one which promises lenience for past crimes, amnesty. If we want a transparent future we must forgive the dark past, or people will violently cling to the darkness to hide their crimes and seek it to reign forever in the world.

We call upon the United Kingdom and United States of America to create a joint force to occupy the Free South, and for the G7 to occupy the Free East and later the Free North, and for the United Nations to occupy the Free West, to safeguard the people of these Free States, these Fully Autonomous Regions, and the people of all of China from slaughter by the Communist Forces.

United Kingdom, our own second mother, whose fruit of the womb we are. Turn not your back on us who gave life to us, and who promised us so much when you left. United States of America, mother of Freedom, light and beacon to the whole world, shine also your light on us, your light so bright that it could dispel all the darkness of the world. France, mother of Enlightenment, great mother of Freedom also, help us attain your great and noble Liberty and be your allies and friends in the world. Canada, so great and free, help us attain also your freedom, that we might together call ourselves the Free World and be allies in the pursuit of good for our peoples and the peoples of the world.

Germany, Italy, Japan, nations so great and free, so marvelous and awe-inspiring in the world, the crimes of World War 2 have never been forgotten and never will be, nor should they ever be, but neither will your great deeds in helping our cause for freedom. Bring your great leadership and assistance to make this cause triumph, for whereas your nations were once an axis of evil you are now champions and titans of good, and it is us that suffer the rule of a cruel and belligerent party.

Battleships speak louder than words, and we call upon you to move troops closer to the region now so that a new, large part of the Free World can emerge, and the 1.4 billion people of China can be a friend and ally to you all in the causes of Freedom and Democracy and the well-being of humanity throughout the world.

Do this rather than allowing the Communist – North Korean – Iranian axis of evil to gain any stronger a foothold in the world then it already has, after which the specter of horrible world war must once again fall upon the world.

It is a bold thing that we are proposing, with the occupation of foreign forces from the Free World, but revolutions, civil wars, and all wars are most horrible and disastrous things, and the world must resolve to find and try methods to achieve such transitions peacefully and without bloodshed. But not with impotent words that the Communist Party of China will just ignore and shrug off. Only together can the Free World force the Communists into acquiescing peaceful, when they see that resistance is futile.

We call upon all parties to do everything in their power to ensure a peaceful transition. We call upon the Communist Party not to repress the peoples' peaceful demands for and transition to Liberty, and thus to force them into violence and desperate measures.

One Country, One System: A Democratic China, and the complete death of Communism. We the People have spoken. Xi Jing Ping: Tremble and Obey. You have no Mandate from the people to rule, but are ordered to step down.

ADDENDUM

Corporate Collaboration

Google and other collaborators in communism and tyranny must be punished.

Adolph Hitler and his Nazi Party came to power in January 1933, and on March 20th of the same year they established the infamous Dachau concentration camp, and the repression of the Jews and their political opponents began immediately, with over 60,000 imprisoned by April.

Despite broad international calls for an economic boycott, IBM enjoyed business relations with the Nazis and increased its investment in Germany. IBM's prodigious and highly efficient punch card system was a pivotal aid in the Nazi genocide of Jews, Gypsies, and other supposed 'sub-humans'.

"Without IBM's machinery, continuing upkeep and service, as well as the supply of punch cards, whether located on-site or off-site, Hitler's camps could have never managed the numbers they did."

Thank you IBM.

IBM's motto is "THINK". We THINK genocide is wrong. We THINK terror is cruel. We THINK terror is humiliation. We THINK you helped one of the worst regimes in history commit one of the worst crimes in history. We THINK your odium reached the high heavens.

Today the criminal corporations helping the Communist in their domestic repression and belligerent foreign policy *must* be held accountable. *Google*. The Massachusets Institue of Technology (MIT) with SenseTime, SenseNets, Netposa and iFlytek. Thermo Fisher. Amax. AMD. And many more.

All collaborators in tyranny must be stopped and held official accountable, and we call upon *the people themselves*, throughout the Free World, to stop these companies and to make the price of collaboration too high to continue.

Companies as well as governments should be on the right side of history.

Enemies of the People

Also, we call upon the traitor Pansy Ho to reflect upon her roots. Your illustrious Great Granduncle, Sir Robert Hotung, "the Grand Old Man of Hong Kong", financed Sun Yat-sen in his struggle to create the Republic of China, and now you show yourself to be not a friend of the people, but an enemy.

The Free World and its Free Market and institutions *created* your family. Kom Tong Hall, 7 Castle Road, Central, now houses the Dr. Sun Yat-sen Museum, and is the former residence of your own Great Grandfather Ho Kom-tong. Robert Ho Shai-lai, second son of Sir Robert Hotung, was a General and later Ambassador in the KMT, who renounced his British Nationality to become a citizen of the Republic of China.

How sad that your branch of the family fell to the vice and disgrace of gambling and casinos, whores and crime, and so also you yourself have fallen to the vice of communism, of tyranny, of falsehood and deceit.

A family that stood with a movement for truth and justice and safety, that contained also the black seed of its opposite. Was your father so envious of the fame and wealth and illustrious history of your cousins? How did your branch fall so far into the depths of crime and corruption?

We call upon the French government to strip her of her honor, the Ordre National Du Merite, the National Order of Merit, and for all governments of the Free World to strip them of honors who stand against Freedom and Democracy in China. And we in Hong Kong must have a system of consequences for people like Pansy Ho and Junius Ho who are clear and flagrant enemies of the people. For we cannot beat an entire police force, but we can hold certain individuals accountable, the individuals who command them.

Religion

The crackdown on Religious Freedom by the Communist regime is brutal, and it is not the right or role of a government to interfere in the Religious Liberty of its subject. But it is important, we believe, for the people of Hong Kong and China to reflect here why they are cracking down so hard on Religions, and the great hope that these Religions play in the struggle for Democracy in China.

China will become the World's Most Christian Nation within 15 years, with Christianity growing spectacularly in China, faster than it grew in the Roman Empire. The underground Christianity that exists in China is a matter of great awe, and reminds one of the historical, persecuted Christianity of Rome that later rose up to conquer that nation and the world.

The Judeo-Christian tradition produced the bedrock of the societies which produced the philosophies of the Liberty of the Individual. The stress on the Individual and his unmitigated relationship with God. The stress on the responsibility of *every* Individual towards his neighbor *and the state*, and the disasters that befall both the Individual and the state when the Individual derelicts his duty and becomes corrupt.

The stress on speech, on the word; the true word of God, and the true word of man. That truth must reign in the Individuals heart and upon his tongue even at the price of his life, the cost of death, of torture and social ridicule. That truth must be freely spoken. That falsehood is abhorrent, an affront to God. *Equality before God*. Judgment in truth, for all, upon merit, with punishment everlasting.

Varying cosmological beliefs have different philosophies of the individual, which vastly affect how individuals and societies perceive themselves and function in their relationships. Not a god-king on earth among the political class, interceding between the heavens and the earth, the gods and the people, *but a Sacred and Sovereign Individual*, whose liberty, action, voice, and mind were necessary to safeguard the state from collapse into tyranny and chaos.

Whilst the Communist party wants to crack down on any form of thought that is not pure Communism, the rise of Abrahamic Monotheism is particularly dangerous for them. There is great hope in the rising Christianity in China, and in the Islamic Faith in Xinjiang, for the cause of Democracy. The rise of a people who *will* suffer for truth. Who *do* already suffer but do *not* give up. Even at the price of their life. Even at the cost of death. We see this also in the steadfast uprightness of members of Falung Gung and Tibetan Buddhists and other religious traditions.

Sun Yat-sen himself was baptized in Hong Kong on the 4th of May 1884. We believe the rise of Christianity and monotheism guarantees a massive demand for civil liberties, of rights and responsibilities, that no government on earth could forever suppress.

ENDING

The Pearl River Group will never again use its name on any future document or action, and if anyone ever does use this name then it is not us, but an imposter.

We close by saying that our goals are not only possible, but they are the greatest possibility, the only likely future for China, and the world, but must be sought for and striven for, suffered for and paid for.

The only thing that seems impossible to us is the continued reign of one-party Communist dictatorship. Crushing people 'for the people'. Kidnapping people 'for the people'. Torturing people 'for the people'.

People of China, free brothers and sisters, not only *are* there alternatives to the CCP, but those alternatives are the only likely future for China, but must be fought hard for. Let no amount of suffering turn you back.

And Free World, do not turn your back on the call of the Chinese people for your help. For if we fail and die, and Communism reigns, that you are their next target, or rather, you have long been their target who they have worked long to undermine. *Tyranny anywhere threatens Freedom everywhere. Tyranny for anyone will become tyranny for everyone.*
