


RAUEMI 1 / RESOURCE 1: SUGGESTED CLEANING PROCEDURES TO REOPEN AND KEEP OPEN A SITE (adapted from <u>Crewcare</u> Commercial Cleaning website)

Level One Standard Clean – (site has been vacant / unused throughout the Pandemic)

- Cleaning and disinfecting all touch points at a site including door handles, switches, taps, doors, and floors
- Complete standard clean of premises
- All touchpoints sprayed with sanitiser or 50:50 bleach solution
- Floors and soft furnishings vacuumed
- No closure required while work is carried out and work can be done by anyone wearing appropriate PPE



Level Two Precautionary Clean – (site open / used with no confirmed COVID-19 case(s) throughout the Pandemic)

- Cleaning and disinfecting all Level One areas and everything up to two (2) metres high including walls, glass, and under furniture
- Includes entrances, foyers, reception, office areas, meeting rooms, stairs, corridors, kitchens and lunchrooms
- Toilet areas included with extra precaution taken if the area is possibly high-risk or infected with bacteria or virus
- Involves closing off areas frequented by people and, while it may be done by anyone wearing <u>appropriate PPE</u>, it is advisable to also have professional supervision onsite

Level Three Deep Clean – (site has been visited / used by confirmed COVID-19 case(s) during the Pandemic)

- Cleaning and disinfecting using a high-level procedure that involves fogging with suitable chemicals
- Heat treatment with the temperature maintained according to site and room condition
- Vaporisation or dry fogging process with rooms airtight and workers in <u>full PPE</u> gear
- Surface cleaning based on CDC guidelines
- Extracting all fog and toxic gas from the room
- Equipment and personnel decontamination with professional equipment
- Involves assistance from Chemcare for infection control and needs to be carried out by a professional cleaning company
