In July, the Pharr EDC officially broke ground on the new Commodities Integrated Logistics (CIL) facility in Pharr.

CIL currently has over 1,150,000 SF of warehouse space

and will be expanding its cold storage facility capacity by

10% via the construction of this new 150,600 SF state-ofthe-art facility in Pharr, Texas, called Queenstown Park.

The facility will include 135,600 SF of cold space and 15,000 SF of office space. Queenstown Park will provide processing, storage, and distribution services and fits into several tenets of the prospective Pharr community plan including creating jobs and advancing local economic goals.

The construction of this new facility will result in the employment of approximately 100 full-time employees. Queenstown Park will be located at the Corner of Las Milpas and I Rd. in Pharr.


3rd Quarter • July, August, and September 2022

The City of Pharr has continued its economic trend towards growth and development in the months of July, August, and September of 2022. Throughout this 3rd quarter, Pharr has welcomed new businesses to the community, secured new economic development projects, expanded workforce opportunities, and continued to grow its sales tax collections.

The City of Pharr reported a strong Civilian Labor Force of 32,384 at the end of the second quarter compared to the same time last year (32,147) and unemployment rates of 8.7% (July 2022), 8.2% (August 2022), and 6.9% (September 2022) a great improvement from the same months in 2021.

The City of Pharr remains committed to improving citizens' quality of life and is focused on continuing the positive financial and economic growth it has experienced over this third quarter. We are proud to welcome so many new businesses and economic development projects to our Pharr community!

PHARR SALES TAX COLLECTIONS 3rd Quarter · July, August, & September


