

# This Minecraft YouTuber Built A Working Tank Without Mods

Minecraft allows players to build just so many things. Whether you want to build your own version of Elden Ring or create an in-game GIF, your options are unlimited. It's all about freedom. In Minecraft, you can mix different systems within the game to create some unique creations like a working Minecraft tank.

Good old Mysticat (who you may recognize from their Crossy Road episode) woke up one morning and decided to use violence to build a tank for themselves. You'll likely already know the end result if you've seen any of their content.

Mysticat builds the tank model, then figures out how to drive it around. This is all familiar stuff, but the most fascinating part of the video consists of how they design the firing mechanism. After some off-screen experimentation, they settled on snowballs. They added a few commands to make them explosive, alter their gravity, and even light them up for some visual flair.

Mysticat then invites some of their friends into a big old arena to have a building competition. Mysticat is distrusted at this point, but everyone accepts it anyway. Mysticat summons a tank and alters their builds, providing valuable feedback. You can see it below.
