CANVASS SCRIPT

The important thing in a canvass is to have an authentic connection with the voter. This might take an extra couple of minutes but it's worth it. The script is only a guide – make it your own.

Introduction:
Hello, my Name is I'm working with my Temple/Mosque/Church/Sangha to reach out to voters in our neighborhoods about the things they care about. I'm out here because (share 1-2 sentences about something you care about.)
What do you care about in the community? (You might have to ask this 2-3 times before they open up)
(Let Voter Share Their Story, maybe ask a question about it)
Your vision/concern/interest, sounds a lot like ours and I believe that voting is one way we can have our voices heard about these issues.
Can we count on you to Vote on Tuesday, November 6th?
Response: Yes/Undecided/No

Opt In/Get Involved: We would like to connect again soon and hear more about your ideas to create change in our (city/county).

Can we call/email/text you to remind you to vote?

(Confirm phone or email)
