
- Every webinar will have an assignment that will correspond with the webinar

# **English Discoveries**

- We will be using English Discoveries for most of our lessons.
- Google Chrome is preferred. Firefox is an alternative.

- Students must complete a total of 9 active hours per week

### **CASAS** Pre-Test and Post-Test

- Pre-Test
  - Taken before the start of class
- O Post-Test
  - Taken near the end of the semester
  - After a minimum of 70 hours of instruction
- Goal is to show improvement in all both Reading and Listening
